

CAPITOLIS COOKIES POLICY

Overview

The purpose of this policy is to inform users who visit the Capitolis website what cookies are active, what user data is tracked, for what purpose and how this data is managed. It also instructs users how to opt out, delete or change settings with regards to the collection of this data.

Target Audience

The target audience for this document is all users / visitors to the Capitolis website.

Policy

Capitolis Inc., ("Capitolis", "we", "our" or "us"), uses Cookies to store and retrieve information on and from your browser when you visit our website (the "Site"). The purpose of this document is to help you understand how we use Cookies.

Cookies are small pieces of text placed on your browser by websites that you visit. When you use or access the Site, we may place a number of Cookies files in your web browser, which allow the Site to recognize you, to make the website function properly, and to collect data about you and your usage, as well as to provide business and marketing information to us. When you re-visit our Site, Cookies allow the Site to recognize you, remember your preferences, and tailor your use of the Site. Information provided by Cookies can help us to analyse your use of our Site and help us to provide you with a better user experience.

By using or accessing our Site, you agree that we may use, store, and access Cookies on and from your computer or other device and that we may use additional methods to collect website usage data and IP addresses.

Cookies also enable us (i) to relate your use of the Site to information that you have specifically and knowingly provided to the Site, and (ii) to track your use of the Site. Cookies may be used to enable certain functions of the Site, to provide analytics, and to enable advertisements delivery, including behavioral advertising, to allow us to store your login information and your personal preferences for the Site. Cookies provide us with important usage data, e.g., how often you visit, where you go at the Site, and what you do there. We may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on the hard drive of your computer until you delete them). So long as Cookies are enabled, we may associate information obtained from such cookies with Personal Information that we have collected from you.

When you browse our Site, some Cookies may be set by third parties, over which we have no control. You may also encounter third party Cookies resulting from our use of third party services, which help us monitor traffic on our Site. We do not control the use of these cookies

and you should refer to the relevant third-party websites for more information.

If you would like to delete Cookies or instruct your browser to delete or refuse Cookies, please visit the help pages of your browser. However, please note that if you disable Cookies in your browser, certain parts of the Site may not function as effectively and you may be unable to use some areas of the Site or other features we offer. Please note that if you change computers or web browsers, you will need to disable Cookies once again.
